**Brief Description:**

With the rapid advance and widespread use of mobile technologies, there is little doubt that mobile technologies have permeated into our daily life and exerted great influence on our behavior. There also raises a need for better understanding of their role and impact on school education. The aim of the Workshop on Mobile Technologies for Learning and Teaching within School Environment is to bring together researchers interested in technology enhanced learning with special focus on the classroom application of mobile technologies in school education. The workshop encourages the global exchange of ideas and experiences among scholars, teachers as well as research students from different communities on all topics related to the development, implementation and evaluation of school learning and teaching with the help of mobile technologies.
