

Call for Papers: K-12 Teachers' Forum

Purpose:

The K-12 Teachers' Forum is a sub-conference affiliated to the Global Chinese Conference on Computers in Education 2009. The intent of the Forum is to provide scholars, experts, and teachers from all over the world a platform for the exchange in information educational research and experience. We will invite teachers from Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Macau, and Singapore to participate in our forum. Each city/ region representative is encouraged to submit their topic(s) to the K-12 Teachers' Forum committee for review.

Teachers' Groups

Representatives of each city/ region are suggested to organize a team on behalf of their city/ region (or a group that will participate in cross-municipal or cross-regional mobile research) to instruct and assist teachers in producing papers of higher quality. Except for those from Hong Kong, Guangzhou, and Taipei, each team should be composed of 5-10 people. The teams will also serve as coordinator for teachers on this conference trip. The topics can include but are not limited to:

- Development and research on educational informatization in local schools
- Construction and application of digital campus
- Design and development of digital resources
- Research on innovative curriculum
- Applications of immersive technologies in curriculum
- Research and practice on virtual learning communities
- Evaluation on applications of technologies
- Teachers' professional development on the use of technologies

Submission

At least one paper should be submitted out of every 10 people from each city/ regional team. We also suggest every team to submit an article addressing the information and technology education in their region. Adjustments on the number of papers required of each city/ region will be made later on.

There is no limit in numbers of submission. Submitters are required to participate in the forum. Research abstracts and articles, along with outstanding essays and reports that address regional information education, will be collected and published in the conference essay collection. Outstanding essays will be chosen from each city/ regional committee. Methods of election and calls for papers are to be made by each committee.
